




Action-ready on desk or table, the Xerox 813 copier makes crisp, dry, permanent copies on ordinary paper.

- **1. Document Feed Slot.** Simply insert original. Copies are produced automatically.
- **2. Paper Tray.** Stores and automatically feeds cut sheets of ordinary paper. Buzzer sounds when supply is running low.
- **3. Receiving Tray.** For return of original and copies. When making multiple copies; original will be returned just be-

fore last copy emerges.

- **4. ON/OFF Switch.** Readies 813 for all-day use after brief warmup.
- **5. Quantity Selector.** Dial for number of copies from each original. Makes 1-10 copies automatically.
- **6. REPLACE WEB Light.** High quality copies are ensured by periodic replacement of drum cleaning web.





Directly from your typed, written, printed or drawn original, the 813 faithfully reproduces even the finest details in jet black on white. Makes up to 10 copies at the turn of a dial. The last will be as sharp as the first. The 813 copies colors—ball point pen, pencil, crayon markings—anything that can be put down on paper.

Specifications

Physical dimensions: Length: 26"; Height: 18"; Width: 20"; Weight: 190 lbs.

Electrical requirements: Input voltage 107 to 125 volts, 60 cycles per second, single phase. Current 12 amps (Copier should have sole use of 15 amp circuit). Power consumption 1400 watts.

Input material: Paper weight 9 lb. to 32 lb.; maximum size $9'' \times 14''$; minimum size $5\frac{1}{2}'' \times 5\frac{1}{2}''$. Acetate jacket allows copying smaller originals.

Maximum image area: $8\frac{1}{2}$ " x 13".

Copy paper characteristics: Paper weight 20 lb. bond; minimum size $8'' \times 10''$; maximum size $8\frac{1}{2}'' \times 14''$.

Copy speed: First copy delivered in approximately 25 seconds. Additional copies delivered 5 per minute.

Copy characteristics: Copy reduced approximately 6% from original size.

Modes of operation: Single copy (approximately 25 seconds for copy to be delivered). Multi-copy (up to 10 copies at setting of copy dial). 5 copies per minute. Consecutive copy (one copy may be fed into the Copier on top of another, in chain fashion).

Xerox 2400

For the high volume user, the masterless 2400 duplicates 40 copies per minute directly from your original. Automatic sorter can be added to give you completely new duplicating capability right in your own office.

Xerox 720

The high speed 720 brings new economy in medium-to-high volume duplicating range.

Point of need convenience, economy, and simplicity in a desktop copier that returns 660 copies per hour.

Xerox 330
