1. Betting is strictly prohibited.
2. The pistol will not be fired until all competitors ARE SET and STEADY on their marks according to A.A.A. RULES.
3. Competitors carry same number throughout the programme.
4. Numbers should be affixed well up on the singlet.
5. Under no circumstances will the start of a race be delayed, and competitors should be ready to go to their marks when called upon by the steward.
6. The Committee reserve the right to combine Heats where necessary to make the racing interesting.
7. Officials and Press only, allowed inside the ring.
8. The Committee will not hold themselves responsible for any loss, theft, or accident which may occur at this meeting.
9. In the event of any dispute, the decision of the Referee is final.
10. No novelty events will be started by pistol.
11. The Committee reserve the right to cancel any event where entries are insufficient.

OPEN 14 MILES ROAD RACE

1. The course for the road race has been measured by means of a meter attached to a pedal cycle and following a course as near as possible to that which will be taken by the runners.
2. Competitors in this event must keep to the left-hand side of the road throughout the course. Those failing to do so render themselves liable to disqualification.
3. The race will start with the runners doing two laps and 264 yards on the track, then out on the road, and thence by the main road to Ross-on-Wye, returning by the same route, to finish with one lap on the track.
4. In team races each club can enter any number, but first three only from each club to finish counts for team race prize.

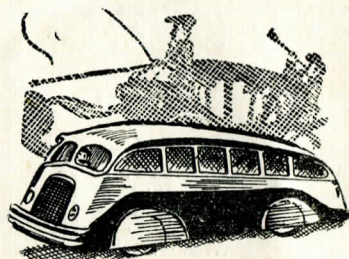
