### NOTICE TO COMPETITORS AND PUBLIC

1. Betting is strictly prohibited.
2. The pistol will not be fired until all competitors ARE SET and STEADY on their marks according to A.A.A. Rules.
3. Where numbers are worn for events, they must be affixed well up on the body.
4. Under no circumstances will the start of any event be delayed, and competitors should be ready to go to their marks when called upon by the steward.
5. In the event of any dispute, the decision of the Referee is final.
6. The Committee reserve the right to cancel any event where entries are insufficient.
7. OFFICIALS AND PRESS ONLY ARE ALLOWED INSIDE THE ENCLOSURE.

### OPEN 14 MILES ROAD RACE

1. Competitors in this event must keep to the left hand side of the road throughout the course. Those failing to do so render themselves liable to disqualification.
2. The course for the race has been accurately measured to conform with regulation (1) above.
3. The race will start with the runners doing two laps and 264 yards on the track, then out onto the road, and thence by the main road to Ross-on-Wye, returning by the same route, and finishing with one lap on the track.
4. Clubs may enter 6 in a team, but only the first three to finish count for the team prize.

### LIGHT TRAILER PUMP DRILL CONTEST

1. Teams to consist of 4 men, and to get to work from open water (tank) using two lengths of suction, two lengths of 75ft. canvas delivery hose, and hit target.
2. The times will be taken from the starting whistle until the target falls. The only penalties will be for dropped equipment (2 sec. in each case). Hose must be rolled in the standard way.
3. Draw to take place on the Field on 9th June, 1956.
