This is an automatic machine for xerography - dry, electrical photography - forming a picture by electrostatic charges on a selenium drum. It produces permanent copies on ordinary paper at the rate of more than six per minute.

Mitcheldean began pilot assembly of 914 copiers more than a year ago following which the first new assembly building, of 25,000 sq.ft., for quantity production, was completed four months ago. World-wide demand has been so great that construction is beginning on yet a further 22,000 sq.ft. development - for completion before the autumn of this year.

The 914 office copier is marketed by Rank-XeroX Limited a Company jointly owned by The Rank Organisation and the Xerox Corporation of America and covers all world markets outside the United Kingdom. Export demand is increasing greatly and copiers are at work in France, West Germany, Austria, Italy, Holland, Belgium, Norway, Sweden, Denmark, Switzerland, Mexico, and Australia.
