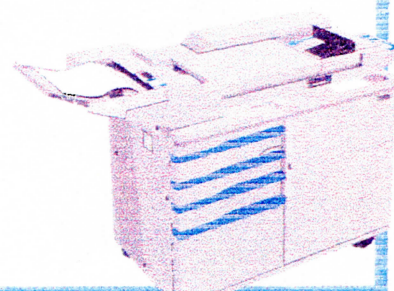
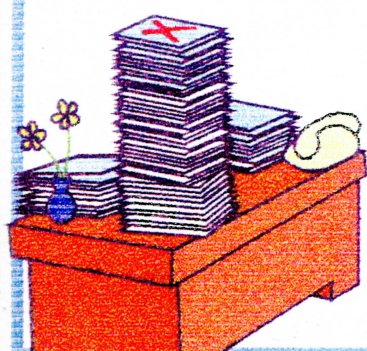


THE BOSS

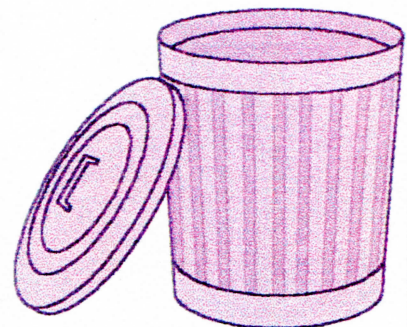
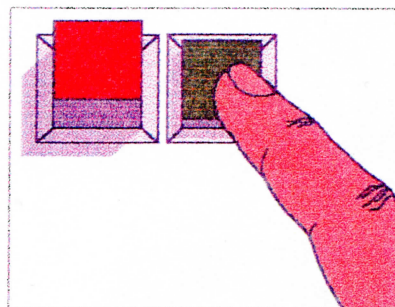
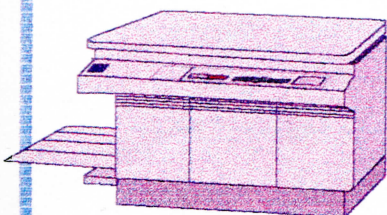




THE RUB DOWN JOB

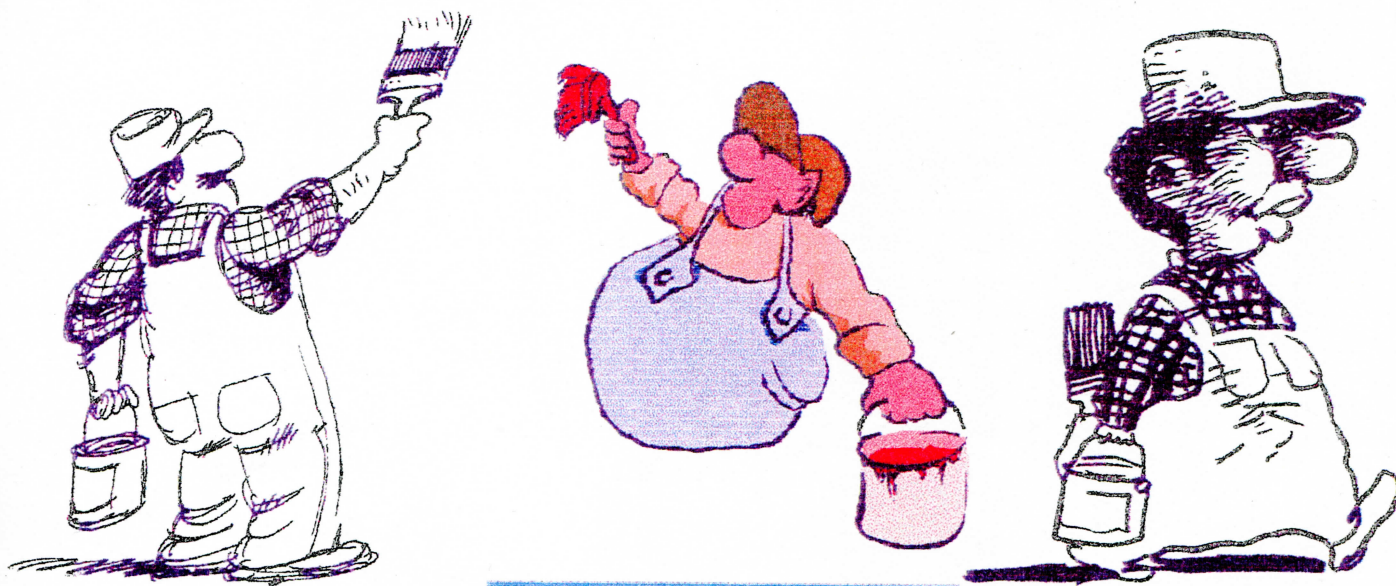




THE BOYS ON THE PAINTLINE

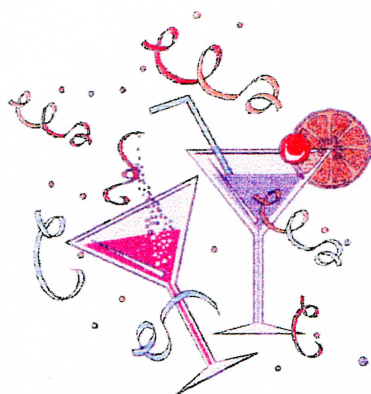




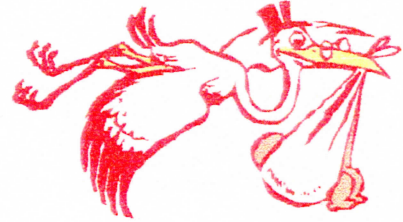
FAREWELL BOYS
